**What does the Bible say about Humility with One Another?**

Romans 12:10

Love one another with brotherly affection. Outdo one another in showing honor.  
Outdo one another = eagerness  
Showing Honor = "give preference"

Philippians 2:3-4

<sup>3</sup> Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility count others more significant than yourselves. <sup>4</sup> Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others.

1 Peter 5:5

Likewise, you who are younger, be subject to the elders. Clothe yourselves, all of you, with humility toward one another, for God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble.

***Jesus wants His church to be Humble with One Another***

**What does Humility with One Another look like?**

John 13:4-5

<sup>4</sup> He laid aside his outer garments, and taking a towel, tied it around his waist. <sup>5</sup> Then he poured water into a basin and began to wash the disciples' feet and to wipe them with the towel that was wrapped around him.

John 13:12-14

<sup>12</sup> When he had washed their feet and put on his outer garments and resumed his place, he said to them, "Do you understand what I have done to you?" <sup>13</sup> You call me Teacher and Lord, and you are right, for so I am. <sup>14</sup> If I then, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet."

*I'm here to serve you with eagerness and gladness*

**How is it possible to become Humble with One Another?**

1 - You must live with active awareness that you've been given a salvation you don't deserve

Philippians 2:1-6

So if there is **any** encouragement in Christ, **any** comfort from love, **any** participation in the Spirit, **any** affection and sympathy,<sup>2</sup> complete my joy by being of the same mind, having the same love, being in full accord and of one mind. <sup>3</sup>Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility count others more significant than yourselves. <sup>4</sup>Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others. <sup>5</sup>Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus
